As a member of the Hopkins Education Foundation (the "Foundation") board I will:

- 1. Consider myself a trustee of the Foundation and do my best to ensure that the Foundation is well maintained, financially secure, and operating in the best interests of our constituents.
- 2. Actively participate in board meetings and Foundation activities.
- 3. Be respectful of the other members of the board and the constituents I serve.
- 4. Keep well informed of developments that are relevant to issues that may come before the board.
- 5. Recognize that all authority is vested in the board and not with individual board members.
- 6. Refer constituent or staff issues to the proper officer or committee.
- 7. Recognize that the board member's job is to ensure that the Foundation is well managed.
- 8. Declare any conflicts of interest between my personal life and my position on the board, and to avoid voting on issues that constitute a conflict of interest.
- 9. Act in a respectful manner towards fellow board members and the general public in matters concerning the Foundation and the affairs of the Hopkins School District.
- *10.* Support the executive director and staff.

As a member of the board I will not:

- 1. Use the Foundation for my personal advantage.
- 2. Discuss confidential matters of the Foundation with anyone other than fellow board members or the executive director.
